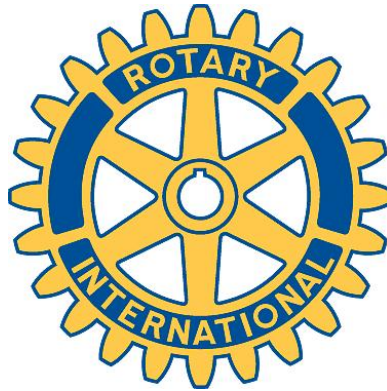

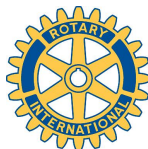

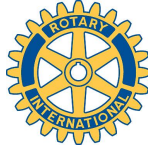

Its history is that First Bank Richmond has held such auctions at the bank, for the purpose of raising funds for United Way, with just its own employees for about 1 week and generated close to \$1,813.00 and, in the past, have raised up to \$2,600.
