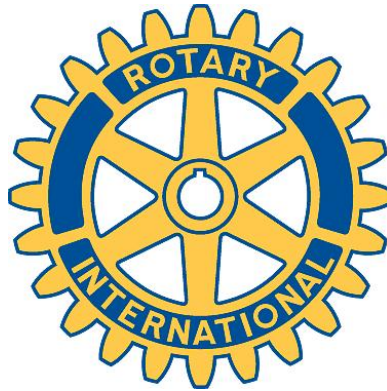

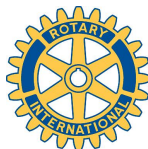

Angela Addison updated us on current programs and goals of Genesis during lunch on March 18th. Genesis serves 5 Indiana counties and works closely with Preble County, Ohio. The shelter's average daily occupancy is 7 people, but can hold up to 25 at one time. Angela said the upcoming month of April, which is National Crime Victims Awareness Month, is very important to Genesis. They are planning intervention and self defense activities for the month of April.

Angela, who serves as a victim's advocate, currently educates area students to be aware of abuse and intervention. Through 2 books, "A Safe Place to Live" and "Something is Wrong at My House," students learn about types of abuse and how to react if it happens.

Genesis is funded through various grants, United Way, HUD and private donations. As reported by Jodie Dwyer.
