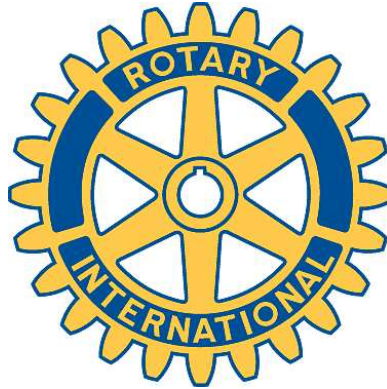

Last Week’s Program:



Renee Arnett, a Richmond Civic Theatre board member, spoke to the club about the local theatre, giving some of the history of the 100-year-old building and of Norbert Silbiger, long-time director.

She said that the cost of a production ranges from seven to ten thousand dollars, although most theatre participants are volunteers. She invited Rotarians to become involved with the theatre.

In addition to the customary fare offered by the theatre since 1941, Renee described an outreach program called Show Stoppers, which introduces young people to theatre by affording them chances to see productions at a deeply discounted price. Additionally, she noted Studio 10 productions, which require participants and audiences to be eighteen years of age or older.

A capital campaign is underway, with \$400,000 having been raised in cash and pledges.

Renee ended by discussing the bonding that occurs at the theatre, the friendships that develop, and the overall pride those involved take in the productions themselves. jk
